Armour Thyroid[®] Shortage is Affecting your Patients. Partners in Care Can Help.

Armour Thyroid®'s manufacturer, Forest, has been plagued by unexplained product shortages and back orders. In 2009, they reformulated the product to improve dissolution. While Armour Thyroid® was being reformulated, availability problems forced some patients to switch to the similar natural thyroid drugs Nature-Throid™ and Westhroid™. When the reformulated Armour Thyroid® came back on the market, many patients complained that the reformulated product was not working as well as before, and some patients switched to Nature-Throid™ and Westhroid™ again. Currently, there is a nationwide shortage of Armour Thyroid®, and Forest has not indicated any date when the product will be back on the market.

Nature-Throid™ and Westhroid™, distributed by RLC Labs and until recently, manufactured by TimeCap Labs, are also unavailable.

Many patients have tried other types of thyroid hormones, such as levothyroxine and liothyronine, and have found that Desiccated Natural Thyroid is the only form that works adequately for them, reporting that they simply do not feel as well when they take levothyroxine alone or with liothyronine.

The theory behind the use of synthetic T4 alone (levothyroxine) is that the thyroid gland converts T4 to T3.

However, as the thyroid gland of a hypothyroid person is already malfunctioning, its ability to convert T4 to T3 may be hampered as well. T3 (liothyronine) is commercially available only as an immediate acting preparation, which often causes undesirable side effects including palpitations.

Currently, Desiccated Natural Thyroid - Thyroid USP (porcine) - is available only through compounding pharmacies.

The specifications for Thyroid USP (porcine) require that each grain contains levothyroxine (T4) 34.2-41.8 mcg and liothyronine (T3) 8.1-9.9 mcg. This produces a T4:T3 ratio of 4.22:1 to meet the stringent standads for a U.S. Pharmacopeia monograph, with a permissible variance of \pm 10%.

Our compounding pharmacy uses Thyroid USP that is shown by analysis to meet the same potency standards as that which is used to manufacture commercial products that are currently on backorder.

Commercially available tablets contain fillers and excipients that may not be tolerated by all patients. When we compound customized dosages, we have the ability to omit any problem-causing inactive ingredients and substitute non-reactive fillers.
